CAKE: Absolute program needs.

★ Fingering Systems:

- German (by far most common globally and in the United States)
- Left hand plateau key or tone hole
- With or without high D, Eb, E, F keys; C#, Ab trill keys

★ Brands:

- Fox, Renard, Moosmann, Schreiber, Puchner, Wolf, Takeda, Heckel, Bell
- Wooden or polypropylene

★ Reeds: hand-adjusted

★ Accessories:

- Cleaning swab (silk or pair for wing/boot joints)
- Seat strap (NOT neck strap)
- Reed case

ICING: Desirable and realistic characteristics.

★ Fingering Systems:

- High D key
- F, F#, Eb, C# key rollers

★ Brands:

- Fox, Renard, Moosmann, Puchner, Heckel, Bell
- Wooden or polypropylene

★ Reeds: hand-made

★ Bocals (2):

- Fox, Moosmann, Leitzinger, Heckel, Wolf
- Lengths 2-3 (1-2 if Heckel)
